aboriginal, Nemar Luck, who is alleged to have been the murdorer of three Japanese at Port Keats, in 1930, and who made a seasational escape from Fanny Bay gool on September 23, was located by a police black tracker, Smiler, on Delissabille Island early this morning.

Smiler crept on Nemar Luck, taking him by survrise, but the wanted man put up a terrible struggle for over a quarter of an hour.

Another aboriginal went to Smiller's assistance but was knocked unconscious. Smiler and Nemar Luck rolled towards the edge of a cliff during the light and Smiler threw his adversary over. Nemar Luck's fate is unknown and the police are still searching for him.
