Melbourne Herald 19th February 1934 WILL NEMARLUCK "SHOOT IT OUT?" Native Report Of Armed Resistance POLICE PREFER GUNS TO SPEARS From Our Special Representative

DARWIN, Monday.-Nemarluck, the notorious Fitzmaurlee River aborigine murderer and gaol breaker, is alleged to be awaiting with two shot-guns and a supply of cartridges the anticipated police pursuit party, in the next dry season

This information was given to the police today by a Fitzmaurice River aborigine, who came overland to Dar-win from Nemarluck's camp at Point

Keats. The shotguns, the police believe, are the weapons stolen from two prospecthe weapons stolen from two prospec-tors, Koch and Arinski, when Nemar-luck's tribesnen, now awaiting trial for murder, killed the men on the Fitz-maurice River in November, 1932. The news has not disturbed Constable W. Langdon, who will be one of the party sent to chase Nemarluck. He said today that Nemarluck armed
