Sydney Morning Herald 23rd October 1933 PURSUIT OF ABORIGINAL. DARWIN, Sunday. Constable McNab left Darwin yesterday for Delissaville in an endeavour to capture the escaped aboriginal Nemarluck. The constable will follow Nemarluck's tracks in the direction of Finniss River. Aborigines across the harbour say that Nemarluck died of bullet wounds, having been shot by an aboriginal police tracker when recisting arrest. The story has not yet been confirmed. Constable McNab returned to-day, his search having been unsuccessful.
