

ABORIGINAL MILITANTS SHOW THE WAY—

STORM AT SYDNEY ABORIGINAL MEETING

Sydney: Black militants would have won control of the Foundation for Aboriginal Affairs last Friday night if proxy votes from white members favoring the present executive had not been counted.

During noisy scenes at the meeting, two Special Branch policemen (pictured left) were asked to leave by majority vote, while Liberal MLA Viney also walked out after a narrow vote on his removal.
