

# Aust image 'not good on Aborigines'

PERTH, Wednesday.—  
The chairman of the Australian Council of Aboriginal Affairs, Dr H. C. Coombs, said today that Australia's image was not good overseas because of its treatment of Aborigines.

He was speaking at a press conference at Perth Airport on his arrival from Japan where he had been working as a consultant for the World Bank on the problems of India's international debts.

Dr Coombs said he was not proud of Australia's record of its treatment to Aborigines. Though the image was not totally correct, there were some elements of truth in the accusations.
